

Subject: European Directive 2011/65/EC of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS, recast).

Dear,

The European Directive cited above restricts the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants in the equipment listed in annex I of the directive.

Legrand seeks to go further than the regulation and in the aim of environmental protection and has therefore decided to eliminate the substances covered by this directive from all its products.
